_____ Embryo Recovery and Transfer \$1600.00

*(This is due even if an embryo is not recovered)

*Embryo Transfer fee includes management of one (1) Donor Mare and two (2) Recipient Mares (to be provided by Donor Mare Owner) ultrasounds, semen insemination, non-surgical embryo recovery/attempt, embryonic vesicle transfer to recipient mare and pregnancy examinations at day 14-16, and day 25-35.

*Not included hormones/drugs to synchronize mares, hCG or Sucromate to induce ovulation progesterone administration through day 35 to enhance pregnancy maintenance.

*Mare Owner is responsible for any costs related to semen used for Donor Mare.

_____ (Mare Owner Signature) KSS, and its Lessor(s) makes no warrant or guarantee that the embryo recovery and transfer procedure will result in a pregnancy or that a live foal will be produced as a result of the embryo transfer procedure.

RECEIVED FROZEN SEMEN

Mare Owner receiving frozen semen (identified on pg.1 is responsible for the cost and/or disposition of and remaining frozen semen at the end of the season (Aug.1) to include the cost of returning any unused semen, storing unused semen at \$20.00/month for up to 250 straws, or destroying any unused semen.
