*Foaling Service includes surveillance, monitoring normal foaling and routine umbilical cord care
(Foaling fee does not include drugs or treatment)

BOARD CARE:

_____ \$18.00/day foaling stall and turn out

*Pregnant mare is required to be vaccinated against Eastern and Western Equine Encephalitis, Tetanus, Influenza, Rabies and West Nile Virus approximately 4-6 weeks prior to foaling. It may also be advantageous to vaccinate late-term pregnant mares against rotavirus and colostrum.

_____ (Please Sign) Owner/Agent agrees to pay veterinary fees and charges associated with additional non routine therapy deemed necessary for proper management of the pregnant, foaling or post-partum mare (e.g. oxytocin treatment, uterine lavage or other treatment for retained placenta, etc.) or the newborn foal (e.g. Supplementation with additional colostrum and/or plasma, etc.)

*This contract does not cover any fees associated with breeding the mare back after foaling unless marked on pg. 2 of this contract.
